



**PERMIT TO ALLOW USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT
FOR CHLORPYRIFOS DUSTING OF COVERED BANANA BUNCHES IN QUEENSLAND
PERMIT NUMBER -PER10578**

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

CONDITIONS OF USE

Products to be used:

All registered products containing 500 g/kg CHLORPYRIFOS as their only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Pest	Rate
BANANA	SUGAR CANE BUD MOTH (<i>Opogona glycyphaga</i>) BANANA SCAB MOTH (<i>Nacoliea octasema</i>) BANANA RUST THRIPS (<i>Chaetanaphothrips signipennis</i>)	Apply 2 - 5 grams prepared dust per bunch.

Dust is prepared by mixing at a rate of 100 grams product per 5kg talc.

Critical Use Comments:

- Use Unimin Talc T45B or equivalent to prepare dust.
- Do not apply excessive dust. Apply a light coating of a fine dust to the inside of the bunch cover and the fruit.
- Dusting should occur within a week of bunch covering.
- Apply one application only.

Personal Protective Equipment:

Persons operating under this permit must adhere to the following directions: When opening the container and mixing with talc wear a dust mask or half facepiece respirator, cotton overalls buttoned to the neck and wrist and washable hat, PVC gloves and goggles. When applying the prepared dust wear a dust mask or half facepiece respirator, cotton overalls buttoned to the neck and wrist and washable hat. After use wash hands and contaminated clothing.

Withholding Period:

DO NOT HARVEST FOR 14 DAYS AFTER APPLICATION.

Jurisdiction:

QLD only.

Additional Conditions:

This permit provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.

Export of treated produce:

To allow produce from treated plants to be supplied or otherwise made available for consumption a Maximum Residue Limit (MRL) of 0.5mg/kg for chlorpyrifos is established to cover this use in bananas. This limit applies only to produce marketed and consumed in Australia. Therefore if treated produce is to be exported, due account should be taken of the residue definition and residue limits/import tolerances of importing countries and that any residues must not exceed those requirements of the importing country.
