## CONDITIONS OF USE

### Products to be used:

FYFANON 440 EW INSECTICIDE

Plus other register products containing; 440g/L MALDISON as their only active constituent.

NUFARM MALDISON 500 INSECTICIDE

Plus other register products containing; 500g/L MALDISON as their only active constituent.

HY-MAL INSECTICIDE

Plus other register products containing; 1150g/L MALDISON as their only active constituent.

### Directions for Use:

### Critical Use Comments:

- DO NOT apply more than 3 applications per season, with a minimum retreatment interval of 7 days between consecutive applications.
- Apply when pests appear in crop.
- Adequate coverage is essential in later growth stages of crop. Apply in a spray volume up to 2000L per hectare.

### Withholding Period:

DO NOT harvest for 3 days after last application.

### Jurisdiction:

ACT, NSW, QLD, SA, TAS, NT & WA.

(Note: Victoria is not included in this permit because their 'control-of-use' legislation means that a permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in VIC).

### Additional Conditions:

THIS PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.

Export of treated produce. To allow produce from treated plants to be supplied or otherwise made available for human consumption the APVMA has established a Maximum Residue Limit (MRL) for Maldison in Strawberries at 1 mg/kg. This limit applies only to produce marketed and consumed in Australia. Therefore if treated produce is to be exported due account should be taken of the residue definition and residue limits/import tolerances of importing countries and that any residues must not exceed those requirements of the importing country.
