Product to be used:

SELECT HERBICIDE

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

containing 240 g/L CLETHODIM as their only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Weeds	Rate
PEAS: GREEN AND PROCESSING ANNUAL (<i>Pisum sativum</i>)	'FOPS' RESISTANT RYEGRASS (<i>Lolium rigidum</i>) AND WINTER GRASS (<i>Poa annua</i>)	150-500mL/ha + crop oil (at label rates).

Critical Use Comments:

Apply to young, actively growing weeds for best level of control.

DO NOT apply without the addition of an adjuvant.

DO NOT apply to plants that are stressed by moisture or temperature extremes.

DO NOT apply if rain is expected within one hour of application.

DO NOT apply more than once to any one crop.

Withholding Periods:

DO NOT HARVEST CROPS FOR 28 DAYS AFTER APPLICATION.

DO NOT GRAZE OR CUT FOR STOCK FOOD FOR 28 DAYS AFTER APPLICATION.

Jurisdiction:

WA and TAS only.

Additional Conditions:

THIS PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.

RESIDUES:

To allow produce from treated plants to be supplied or otherwise made available for consumption the APVMA has established the following temporary maximum residue limit (TMRL):T 0.5 mg/kg.
