Products to be used:

NUFARM COPPER OXYCHLORIDE FUNGICIDE

OSPRAY COPPER OXYCHLORIDE-WP AGRICULTURAL FUNGICIDE/BACTERICIDE

Plus all other registered products containing: 500g/kg COPPER (CU) PRESENT AS COPPER OXYCHLORIDE as their only active constituent.

NORSHIELD 750 WP COPPER FUNGICIDE

AG COPP 750 COPPER FUNGICIDE

Plus all other registered products containing: 750g/kg COPPER (CU) PRESENT AS CUPROUS OXIDE as their only active constituent.

NUFARM CHAMPION WP COPPER HYDROXIDE AGRICULTURAL FUNGICIDE

YATES DISEASE CONTROL BLITZEM COPPER FUNGUS SPRAY

Plus all other registered products containing: 500g/kg COPPER (CU) PRESENT AS CUPRIC HYDROXIDE as their only active constituent.

SHALLOTS (<i>A. cepa var. aggragatum</i>)		Cuprous Oxide 1.2 kg/ha or 105 g/100 L
		Cupric Hydroxide 2.2 kg/ha or 200 g/100 L

Critical Use Comments:

DO NOT apply more than 6 applications of copper based sprays per season (including both stand alone copper formulations included in this permit and other products containing copper i.e. Ridomil Gold Plus). The products allowed for use under this permit, should be used in accordance with the Fungicide Resistance Management Strategy for Downy Mildew in onions.

Withholding Period:

DO NOT harvest for at least 1 day after application.

Jurisdiction:

ALL States (except Victoria).

(Note: Vic is not included in this permit as that State's control of use legislation does not require a permit to be issued to cover this use.)

Additional Conditions:

This permit provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

Persons who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.
