Apply by boom sprayer (e.g. Tall Boy spray rigs) or by aircraft. Apply to crop up to a maximum of twice only , with 14 – 28 days between sprays.
		PROPIMAX FUNGICIDE plus other registered products containing: 435 g/L PROPICONAZOLE as their only active constituent.	290mL/ha	
		NUFARM THROTTLE 500 FUNGICIDE plus other registered products containing: 500 g/l PROPICONAZOLE as their only active constituent.	250mL/ha	

Withholding Period:

DO NOT HARVEST FOR 28 DAYS AFTER APPLICATION.

DO NOT GRAZE TREATED VEGETATION, OR CUT FOR STOCKFEED.

Jurisdiction:

ACT, NSW, QLD, SA, NT and WA only.

[Note: Victoria is not included in this permit because their 'control-of-use' legislation means that a permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in VIC]

ADDITIONAL CONDITIONS:

THIS PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.

RESIDUES:

To allow produce from treated plants or animals to be supplied or otherwise made available for human or animal consumption, the APVMA has established the following temporary maximum residue limit (TMRL): **T*0.02 mg/kg** for propiconazole in sweetcorn.

EXPORT OF PRODUCE:

Exported produce must have appropriate residue tolerance limits established in the importing countries and any residues must not exceed the tolerance limits.
