DO NOT apply with wetters or spraying oils. Apply when disease symptoms are first observed when weather conditions favour disease development. Allow a minimum of 7 days between consecutive treatments.
		PROPIMAX FUNGICIDE plus other registered products containing: 435 g/L PROPICONAZOLE as their only active constituent.	290mL/ha	
		NUFARM THROTTLE 500 FUNGICIDE plus other registered products containing: 500 g/l PROPICONAZOLE as their only active constituent.	250mL/ha	

### Withholding Period:

Harvest: DO NOT harvest for 1 day after application.

### Jurisdiction:

NSW, QLD, SA, TAS and WA only.

### Additional Conditions:
