



Corasil New Product Introduction

Corasil is an exciting new Plant Growth Regulator (PGR) for Australian citrus growers as it has the ability to improve profitability from their orchard.

Applied once at the correct timing stage Corasil has the ability to increase fruit size of oranges and mandarins resulting in more fruit being of a higher marketable grade providing improved returns for growers.

Corasil contains the active ingredient Dichlorprop-P and is an auxin based growth regulator. Application of Corasil mimics the natural hormones within the plant. Corasil works simply by increasing the elasticity of the cells within the developing fruit, allowing them greater juice accumulation. The resultant effect at harvest is of fruit of a greater size when applied correctly and used in conjunction with good orchard management practice.

The registration in Australia in October 2007 is the culmination of eight years of research and development work with the citrus industry by Nufarm. Many people -growers, packers, research and development staff from various State DPI and in particular the Australian Citrus Growers Inc (ACG) have assisted Nufarm in developing Corasil in Australia.

Nufarm would like to thank all those that have assisted us in Corasil development so that now Australian growers can utilise this new orchard management tool as have citrus growers from overseas for some years.

Corasil will be available in a 10L plastic drum and is available from Corasil Agricentres only.
