



**PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT  
FOR THE CONTROL OF PSEUDOCERCOSPORA LEAF SPOT IN CUSTARD APPLE**

## CONDITIONS OF USE

### Products to be used:

CABRIO FUNGICIDE

NUFARM CABRIO FUNGICIDE

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 200 g/L PYRACLOSTROBIN as its only active constituent.

CABRIO WG FUNGICIDE

NUFARM CABRIO WG FUNGICIDE

PLUS OTHER REGISTERED PRODUCTS

Containing: 200 g/kg PYRACLOSTROBIN as its only active constituent.

### Directions for Use:

Crop	Disease	Rate
CUSTARD APPLE	PSEUDOCERCOSPORA LEAF SPOT ( <i>P. anonicola</i> )	<b>CABRIO FUNGICIDE</b> 80 mL/100L plus an appropriate wetter, if required.  OR  <b>CABRIO WG FUNGICIDE</b> 80g/100L plus 10 mL/100L of a non-ionic surfactant.

### Critical Use Comments:

- Apply at first signs of disease or following several days of wet cloudy weather.
- DO NOT apply more than 3 applications per season with a minimum retreatment interval of 7 days between applications. Applications should be alternated with the use of other approved fungicides such as mancozeb, carbendazim or copper.

### No Spray zone:

- DO NOT apply when there are aquatic and wetland areas including aquacultural ponds or surface streams and rivers within 50 m downwind from the application area.

### Minimising run-off from areas treated:

Care should be taken to avoid run-off from the treated area, including;

- DO NOT apply within 48 hours of heavy rainfall,
- DO NOT irrigate to the point of run-off, and
- DO NOT apply to waterlogged soils.

### Withholding Period:

DO NOT HARVEST FOR 3 DAYS FOLLOWING APPLICATION.

### Jurisdiction:

NSW & QLD only

**Additional Conditions:**

THIS PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.

**Residues and Export of treated produce.**

To allow produce from treated plants to be supplied or otherwise made available for consumption the APVMA has established a temporary Maximum Residue Limit (MRLs) for pyraclostrobin in custard apple at 5mg/kg.

This limit applies only to produce marketed and consumed in Australia. Therefore if treated produce is to be exported due account should be taken of the residue definition and residue limits/import tolerances of importing countries and that any residues must not exceed those requirements of the importing country.
