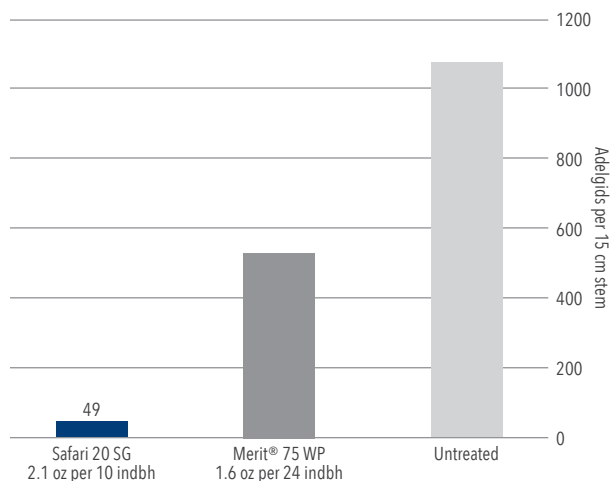

Hemlock Woolly Adelgid	Foliar Spray	4 - 8 oz/100 gallons Spray to runoff
	Soil Drench or Soil Injection	Trunk diameter at breast height: Less than 24", apply 1.1 - 4.2 oz per 10 indbh 24" or more, apply 2.1 - 4.2 oz per 10 indbh Soil drench: Apply 1 - 4 pints of solution per indbh Soil injection: Apply 1 - 32 fl oz of solution per indbh
	Basal Trunk Spray	12 oz/gallon Spray lower five feet of trunk to runoff

1 oz Safari 20 SG = 12 teaspoons, indbh = inches of trunk diameter at breast height
