



**PERMIT TO ALLOW MINOR USE OF AN AGVET CHEMICAL PRODUCT
FOR THE CONTROL OF GRASS AND BROADLEAF WEEDS IN PASSIONFRUIT**

PERMIT NUMBER -PER10954

This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

THIS PERMIT IS IN FORCE FROM 27 NOVEMBER 2008 TO 30 OCTOBER 2013.

CONDITIONS OF USE

Product to be used:

ALL REGISTERED PRODUCTS CONTAINING

Containing: 360 g/L GLYPHOSATE present as the ISOPROPYLAMINE SALT as their only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Pest	Rate
PASSIONFRUIT	GRASS AND BROADLEAF WEEDS	10 - 15 mL of product per litre of water.

Critical Use Comments:

Use the higher rate for woody weeds. Apply as a directed spray around the base of the plants, using a shielded sprayer.

DO NOT allow spray or spray drift to contact any part of the plant or trunk, particularly lower green leaves and green bark. **THIS IS PARTICULARLY CRITICAL WHEN VINES LESS THAN 3 YEARS OLD ARE BEING TREATED, OR ARE ADJACENT TO OLDER VINES UNDERGOING TREATMENT.**

DO NOT apply more than 1 spray per month.

Withholding Period:

Harvest: Not required when used as directed.

Grazing/Stockfeed: Do not allow treated weeds to be used for forage or grazing.

Jurisdiction:

ALL States (except Vic)

(Note: Victoria is not included in this permit because their 'control-of-use' legislation means that a permit is not required to legalise this off-label use in VIC).

Additional Conditions:

THIS PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use the products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the permit particularly the information included in DETAILS OF PERMIT and CONDITIONS OF PERMIT.

TO AVOID CROP DAMAGE:

The sensitivity of some species and varieties of the crops to be treated under this permit has not been fully evaluated. It is advisable, therefore, to only treat a small number of plants to ascertain their reaction before treating the whole crop.

EXPORT OF PRODUCE:

Exported produce or animals must have appropriate residue tolerance limits established in the importing countries and any residues must not exceed the tolerance limits.
