The Nufarm Brendale plant in Queensland produces a range of solid and liquid agricultural formulations of herbicides, insecticides and fungicides, including slow release products.

The site

The site has six manufacturing plants which formulate:-

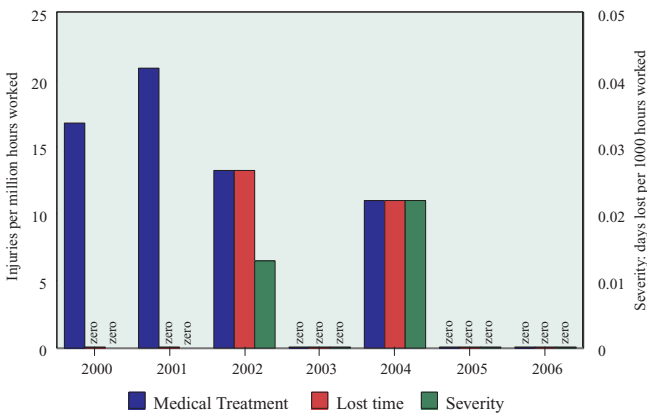
- liquid formulations
- suspension concentrates
- water dispersible granules
- controlled release granules

Health and Safety Performance

We are pleased to be able to report that we have not had a serious injury in 2005 or 2006.

In October 2006 the site achieved 1000 days without an MTI or LTI. With continuing challenges and increasing number of unusual tasks we are mindful of undertaking our jobs safely.

Wastes

Pesticide waste quantities have continued to decrease in line with continued decrease in production volumes.

Landfill waste quantity has decreased in line with a decrease in production volumes. Recycling of waste plastic stretch wrap commenced in November 2006.

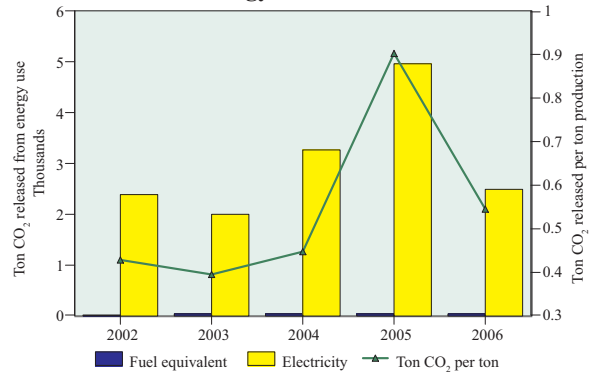

Energy Performance

Overall electricity usage reduced from 2005 in line with decreased production due to continued rationalisation. Productivity based electricity usage also declined mainly due to a reduction in shift work and decommissioning a 160KW powered air compressor that was replaced with smaller 30KW units to service individual plants. This is beneficial to levels of greenhouse gas emissions.

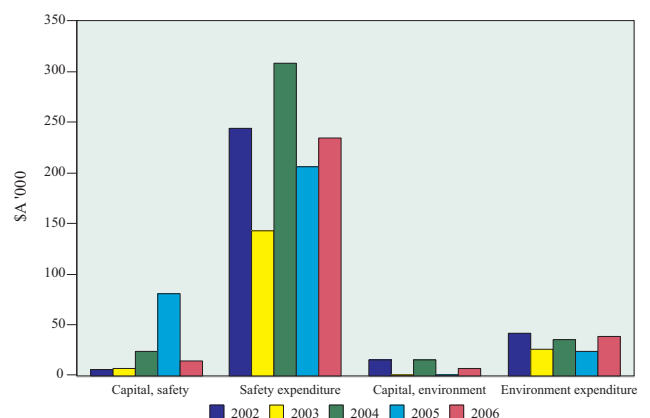


Expenditure

Expenditure



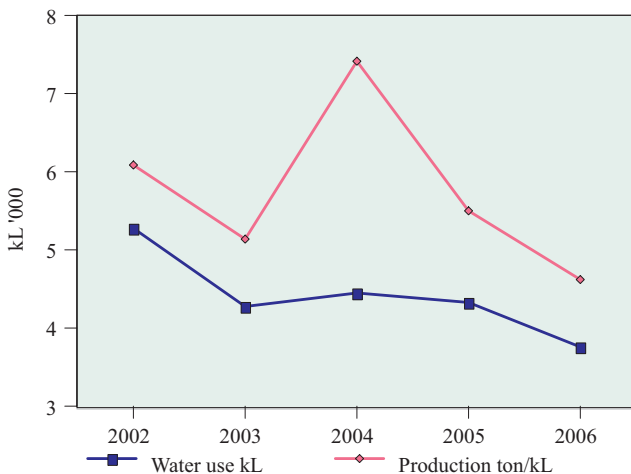
Water Use

Australia is in the grip of drought - nothing unusual - it happens all too often, but the present one is very bad. We keep a close eye on the amount of the water we use in our plant. Even our minor usages get our attention. We have

- Installed low flow shower heads in the change rooms
- Installed dual flush toilets
- Replaced water jet aspirators in the laboratory with pumps
- Captured a large percentage of our stormwater and are using it to irrigate our gardens.
