This permit is issued to the Permit Holder in response to an application granted by the APVMA under section 112 of the Agvet Codes of the jurisdictions set out below. This permit allows a person, as stipulated below, to use the product in the manner specified in this permit in the designated jurisdictions. This permit also allows any person to claim that the product can be used in the manner specified in this permit.

CONDITIONS OF USE

Products to be used:

FILAN FUNGICIDE

NUFARM FILAN FUNGICIDE

Containing: 500 g/kg BOSCALID as the only active constituent.

ROVRAL AQUAFLO FUNGICIDE

Containing: 500 g/L IPRADIONE as the only active constituent.

BRAVO FUNGICIDE

Containing: 720 g/L CHLOROTHALONIL as the only active constituent.

Directions for Use:

Crop	Pest	Rate
ONIONS	NECK ROT (<i>Botrytis allii</i>)	Apply at the rate of 1 kg boscalid product/ha OR Apply at the rate of 2 L iprodione product/ha PLUS 2.3 L chlorothalonil product/ha

Critical Use Comments:

Apply two sprays 7-10 days apart, between flag leaf and the 5 true leaf stage, depending on the presence of conditions conducive to infection.

Apply a further 2 sprays, 7-10 days apart at the commencement of bulbing.

Use a mixture of iprodione and chlorothalonil for two of the applications and boscalid for two applications.

DO NOT apply more than 2 applications of boscalid in any one year.

DO NOT apply boscalid or iprodione more than 10 days after the commencement of bulbing.

Withholding Period:

NOT REQUIRED WHEN USED AS DIRECTED.

Jurisdiction:

TAS and NSW only.

Additional Conditions:

THIS PERMIT provides for the use of a product in a manner other than specified on the approved label of the product. Unless otherwise stated in this permit, the use of the product must be in accordance with instructions on its label.

PERSONS who wish to prepare for use and/or use products for the purposes specified in this permit must read, or have read to them, the details and conditions of this permit.

Export of Produce:

Exported produce or animals must have appropriate residue tolerance limits established in the importing countries and any residues must not exceed the tolerance limits.

RESIDUES:

To allow produce from treated plants or animals to be supplied or otherwise made available for human or animal consumption the APVMA has established the following temporary maximum residue limits (TMRLs): Boscalid Bulb onion T 1.0 mg/kg and Iprodione Bulb onion T 0.2.
