

Hornet™ 430SC approved for brownrot control in Stonefruit

Stonefruit growers are expected to welcome a new label claim for Hornet 430SC fungicide, the new tebuconazole Nufarm launched earlier in the year.



Nufarm says the systemic triazole (DMI) fungicide is now labelled for the control of brown rot in stonefruit, as well as for control of diseases in cereals, grass seed crops, peas and onions.

“Outbreaks of brown rot can be expensive, and difficult to manage,” says Nufarm marketing manager, Nicola Smith.

“Being able to now incorporate Hornet into their spray programmes will make a big difference to growers, and we’re already getting some very positive feedback about this.” One of the key points of difference for Hornet is its suspension concentrate formulation, which offers growers a liquid option for disease control, she says.

Nufarm’s tech team has been working on the new label claim as part of on-going product development.
